About the Dashboard	This interactive map showcases information about health services in Tennessee schools based on interviews with district staff. Explore to gain insights into the landscape of school-based health services across the state!
Queries	Learn about TN school-base health approaches using the “Query” feature: • Enter a query by selecting a filter from a drop down menu. • After selecting queries, scroll down and click “Apply.” • Filtered results will be outlined in teal and the relevant school districts will be listed on the right. • To enter a new query, click on the little trash can icon (top right), then scroll down and click “Reset.” Repeat starting with the first step above. Example query: What districts in the First TN region offer mental/behavioral health services through school-based or school-linked providers? → In Region is any of... SELECT “First TN Region” → In District’s Behavioral Health Service Delivery is any of... SELECT “school-based” AND “school-linked”
Other Features	• Search for any district by typing in the search bar on the top right corner. • Change map view: <i>Zoom in</i> by clicking plus button on the map, <i>zoom out</i> by clicking minus button, <i>reset to original view</i> by clicking home button. • Map layers (center bottom): School districts with interview data (green/base layer), Type of organization (see legend for coding), Region, Number of Schools ○ To see the map layers’ legends, click the stacked square icon on the top right corner of the map, then click “Legend.” • Case profiles: Click on a school district and its corresponding case profile will be displayed at the top as a downloadable pdf file. • County profiles of child well-being in Tennessee: to view, visit the link to the Tennessee Commission on Children and Youth (top right).
